LawTech@Maloney Library is a slate of initiatives designed to help get our students ready for today's technology driven law practice.

The inaugural **LawTech@Maloney Library** event is a program on **Legal Analytics** and will cover new online tools for using docket metadata both to gain strategic litigation advantages and to turbocharge our students' job search (see below). In Spring 2019, we will offer programs on **Cybersecurity for Lawyers**, **Introduction to E-discovery**, and **Basic Tech-Prepare for Practice**.

Other components of **LawTech@Maloney Library** include the library's 3-credit **Law Practice Technology** course offered in the spring semester as well as the library's subscription to the **Procertas Legal Technology Assessment** which is an online, asynchronous, training and assessment program for Microsoft Word, Adobe, and Excel specifically for legal practice. 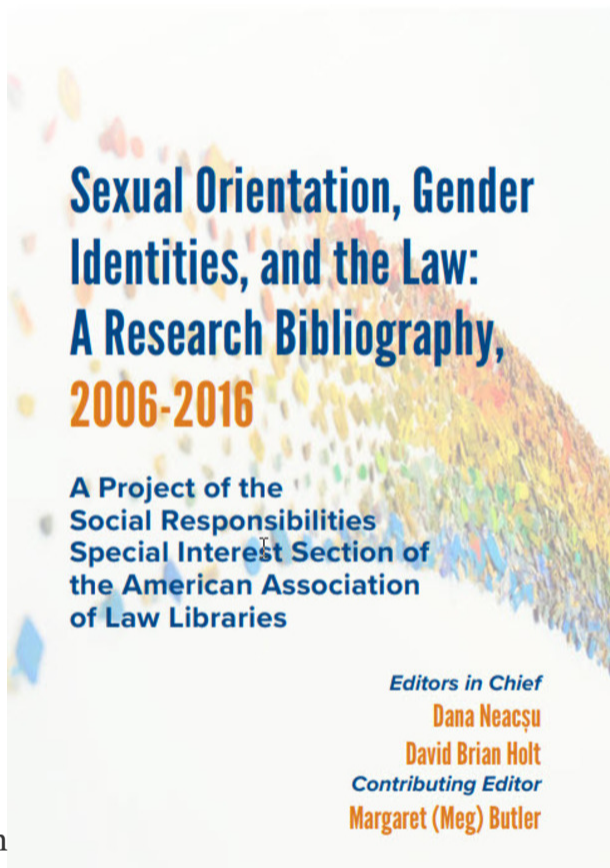

Janet Kearney's New Book Chapters!

Janet Kearney published three chapters in the new book **Sexual Orientation, Gender Identities, and the Law: A Research Bibliography 2006-2016** (Dana Neacsu & David B. Holt eds., 2018). The book provides a bibliometric analysis of legal scholarship to evaluate scholarly trends, patterns, and the development of major themes and voices. Each chapter includes citations that provide summary and evaluative annotations that combine to tell a story of -- and provide raw data on -- the evolution of sexual orientation and gender identity scholarship. Janet's chapters are Immigration and Asylum: Striving for Recognition; Military Employment: Navigating the Repeal of Don't Ask, Don't Tell; and Distinct Topics in Public Sector Employment.
