MY NAME IS STEVE PATTERSON AND I AM THE CHAIRMAN OF THE MISSISSIPPI DEMOCRATIC PARTY. ON BEHALF OF OUR PARTY I WOULD LIKE TO WELCOME YOU TO THIS HISTORIC CAMPAIGN KICKOFF RALLY.
