DETAILED PRESENT OFFENSE: On or about 10/11/16 at approximately 6:43PM, on [REDACTED] Albany County, the subject recklessly caused the death of the victim. An investigation revealed that the subject had consumed a significant quantity of alcohol throughout the course of the day and then operated her vehicle, a 2007 Pontiac Grand Prix, in a reckless manner and while intoxicated, sideswiping the victim's vehicle, a Subaru Outback. The subject was traveling eastbound on the highway, over-corrected, crossed the center median, and struck the front driver's side door of the victim's vehicle, which was on the westbound side of the highway, causing the death of the victim. Test results revealed that the subject's BAC at the time of this accident was at .14 percent.

OFFENDER STATEMENT: The subject was interviewed on 3/7/19 at Albion Correctional Facility and partially agreed with the description of the Instant Offense as indicated in the PSI. The subject insists that the wheel of her vehicle moved through hands of its own accord, pulling her vehicle. She admits to drinking 2-3 mixed Captain Morgan drinks the day of the accident, driving to her parents home, and then later driving back to her own home. It was while en route to her home, that the accident occurred. The subject states she does not recall the actual collision and only remembers waking up inside the ambulance. The subject reports that she suffered a head injury as a result of the accident. The subject states that she will carry the death of the victim with her every day of her life and recognizes that she has impacted not only the lives of the victim's family but the lives of the entire town. The subject has also included her own written statement for the Board's review, which can be found in Section II-B of her parole folder.
