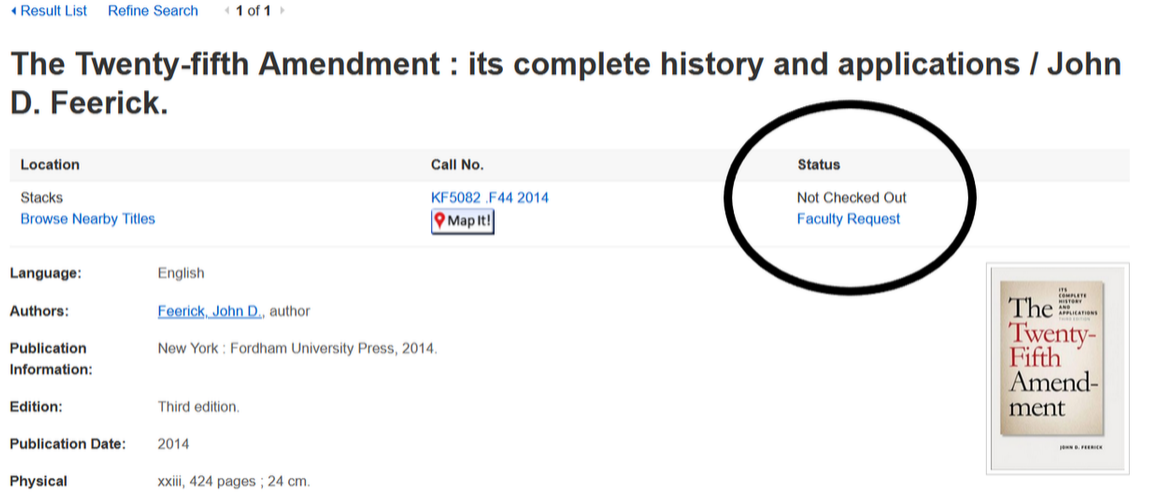
- Three Procortas assessments which focus on legal skills in Excel, Word, PowerPoint, and PDFs; and

Please encourage your students to sign up for the certificate.

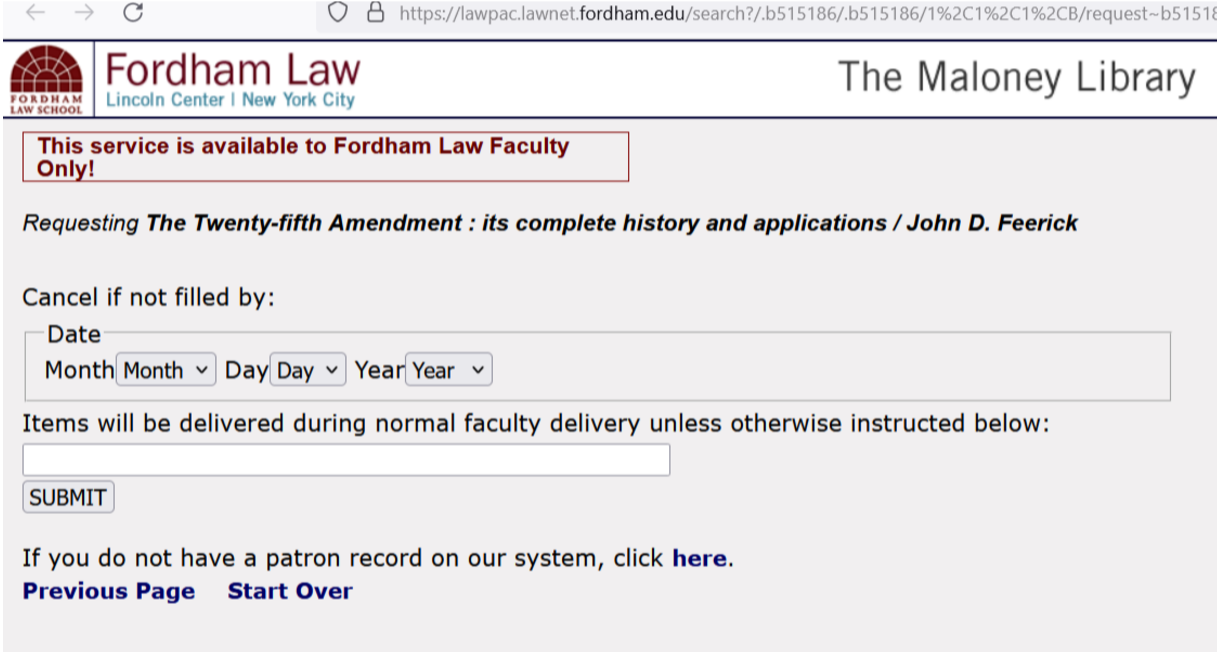
## HIGHLIGHTS
