

Large Demand for Reserve Copies of Casebooks

Fall 2023

- 272 checkouts for all titles
- 22 titles (81%) have had at least 1 check out.

In response to the outrageous cost of casebooks and persistent supply chain delays affecting publishers, Amazon, and the Fordham University Bookstore, the Maloney Library purchases one copy of the required casebook for each 1L course, for required upper-level courses, and for courses tested on the New York Bar Exam, and makes them available to students for two-hour borrowing through our course reserve collection. This year, course reserve borrowing has been at an all-time high.
