In a side room off the main sanctuary of the Uppsala Domkyrka (Great Cathedral in Uppsala Sweden), perhaps Sweden's most beautiful, we saw the following words written both in Swedish and English - on Sept 9, 1984

We pray that the Security Conference now underway in Stockholm

Lord, you know our concern at the international arms race.

You see the fear engendered by the threat of nuclear weapons to human survival

Give courage and patience to those now appointed by their governments to negotiate security and confidence - building measures for the peoples and countries of the world.

You, O God, are our refuge and our hope. Helps us not to grow weary. Give us strength to pray and ask for peace.

In the name of your Son, our Savior

This prayer says that Europe is fearful of the President's military position as well as of the economical trend that is taking shape as one reads this and the European press.

As we go to church to confess our sins does the president do likewise both personally and nationally? So God helps us as a nation.


Pussia see a good bargain and is buying
