DEAR MADAM,

I am writing this letter from Sri Lanka. Let me please first introduce myself to you.

I am a Sri Lankan Tamil aged 56 years married. we are four in the family. Daughter 18 years and Son 10 years of age and wife and myself. I am at the moment without a job. but running five wood Depot selling fire wood. the sale for a day is just enough to meet the expenses of the family. I have already borrowed Twenty thousand rupees and cannot borrow any more and very much worried man as to how I am going to pay back the borrowed money to my friends who helped me to start this business which is running at a loss.

Daughter is studying in the advance level class in Tamil language medium. (it is a pre-university course). I wonder whether she can continue further studies due to my poor financial position. Son is studying in fourth standard Tamil medium. He is very anxious to have a T.V. set complete with Video-deck set. I cannot even dream of fulfilling his desire. I have no lands except a house of my own. That is all about myself in short.

I think I have wasted your time by writing about myself. Excuse me! now I wish to come to the subject. First I wish to thank you, Party and Mr. Mondale for selecting you as a candidate for the Vice-presidential chair. I am sure you and feel that you both would be elected by the most right thinking people of America. I really do not know what the actual political position in America and what the people there have in their minds. But something in my mind makes me feel sure that you are going to be Vice-President of the U.S.A from the 7th of November 1984 and also makes history as being the first lady Vice-President of U.S.A. Specially the ladies of America are going to be very proud of that kind being Vice President.

The people of America would elect you as Vice-President and Mr. Mondale as President of USA officially on the 6th of November 1984.
