I am a history teacher on Cape Cod, Mass (Gerry Studds' district) presently on sabbatical in Spain where I voted absentee ballot.

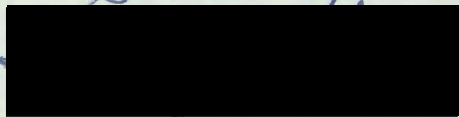
