Come ina nd sit down. 3 My name is McSherry and to my left is Commissioner Raffalli and Commissioner Raffalli has a statement to 4 5 make at this point. I know you've done a lot of 17 time serving this sentence, nine to life and there 18 is an additional four on top of that but there 19 comes a time when we have to have all the 20 information that we need to make a decision right here 21 and now. 22 Yes. 23 So just sit tight and don't get into any trouble. Thank Q 24 you very much. 25 Okay, thank you. A
