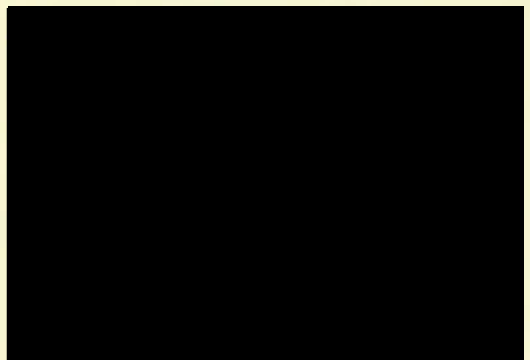

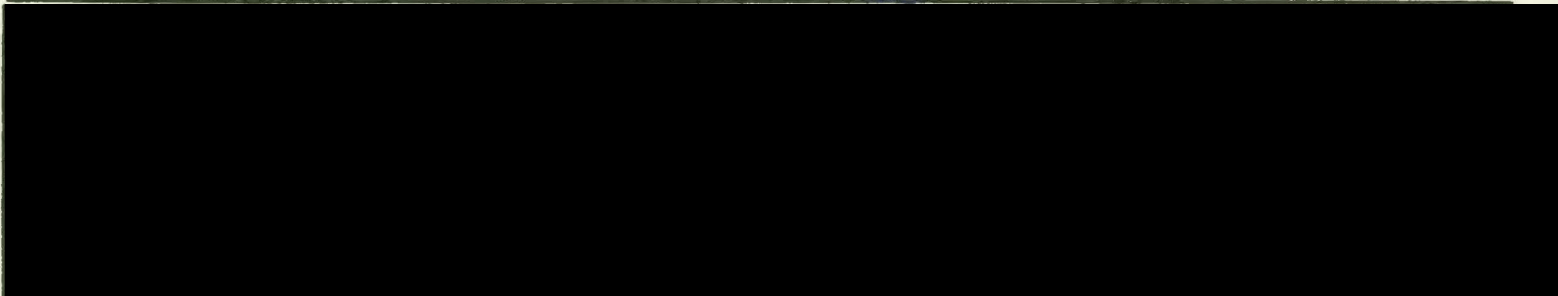
one year ago to talk to President Reagan (83)
