Dear M^r Ferraro,

As you know New Zealand Labour Government has a longstanding policy of abhorring nuclear weapons of any kind and to this end Labour Party policy made it clear that it supported a nuclear free New Zealand.

At our recent elections 64% of N.Zers voted for candidates promising a Nuclear Weapon Free New Zealand and a ban on nuclear propelled & armed warship visits.

N.Z. Labour Government appears to be under heavy pressure from the United States to "change its mind" on this issue. I would ask if you could do what you can to stop your country putting pressure on my Government to change its policy of making New Zealand Nuclear Weapons Free
