I am a Peace Corps Volunteer in service to the Ministry of Agriculture of Cameroon. I just wanted to write to you to tell you how thrilled I was that you were selected to run for Vice-President on the Democratic ticket this year. I voted for you and Mr. Mondale on my absentee ballot from Massachusetts, which I unfortunately received only five days before the election.

From what I was able to follow of the campaign, through radio broadcasts and clippings sent by friends, you were terrific.
