<u>Findings</u>: (Page 1 of 1)

Appellant challenges the June 2021 determination of the Board, denying release and imposing a 24-month hold. The instant offense consisted of the appellant driving a car and crashing into a pedestrian driving a bicycle, causing the cyclist's death. Appellant later blew a .17% B.A.C. Appellant raises many issues. One of the issues raised is a claim the Board failed to properly depart from the COMPAS.

The COMPAS puts appellant's arrest risk in the low category. But the Board decision states there is a reasonable probability appellant would not remain at liberty without violating the law. As such, this is a departure from the COMPAS. But the Board decision doesn't specify any individualized scale they are departing from. As such, since the COMPAS departure wasn't properly done, a de novo is warranted.

<u>Recommendation</u>: Vacate and remand for de novo interview.
