Findings: (Page 1 of 1)

Appellant challenges the September 2021 determination of the Board, denying release and imposing a 18-month hold. Appellant's instant offense is for shooting a store employee during an armed robbery of the store, and then leading police on a wild car chase in dangerous conditions. Appellant raises many issues. In general, appellant challenges the accuracy of many documents and facts.

Most of the issues raised by appellant are incorrect, as the Board is entitled to rely upon the official reports. However, in reviewing the matter, the Board decision states this is appellant's third New York State incarceration. That statement in the Board decision is incorrect, as this is only appellant's second New York State incarceration. As such, since the decision is partially based upon erroneous information, a de novo interview is warranted.

<u>Recommendation</u>: Vacate and remand for de novo interview.
