<u>Findings</u>: (Page 1 of 1)

Appellant challenges the September 2021 determination of the Board, denying release and imposing a 24-month hold. Appellant's instant offense is for driving her car at a high rate of speed right into a group of pedestrians, striking and killing two of them, and then fleeing the scene. Appellant raises many issues. One of the issues raised is an alleged improper COMPAS departure.

First of all, appellant has an EEC. However, the Board decision used the deprecation standard in the decision, which is statutorily incorrect. Thus, a de novo is warranted.

But secondly, the Board decision also stated they are not departing from the COMPAS, but then did depart from the low risk of arrest score by stating there is a probability the appellant would not remain at liberty without violating the law. And no reason for the departure was given, nor was the scale cited. So a de novo is also warranted on this issue as well.

<u>Recommendation</u>: Vacate and remand for de novo interview.
